Combustible

twice a week
in the specified bag

raw kitchen garbage kitchen waste, egg shells, cooling gel etc drain water	waste paper tissues, cigarette butts, paper diapers flush feces in the toilet	scrap wood cut grass, scrap wood dry first	plastic goods video tapes, CDs, cassettes, washing pales, stationery, toys
leather goods footwear, bags, boots	rubber products rubber balls	unwashable plastics mayonnaise, ketchup, unwashable trays	clothes, cloths old clothing, towels, stuffed toys used clothing that can still be used - to the Neagari Kurukuru Workshop

Non-combustible

once a month
in the specified bag

<p>please wrap in paper and a bag before disposing</p> <p>glass and ceramics</p> glasses, mirrors, plates, bowls, flower pots, milk bottles, cosmetics glass containers	<p>spray cans, gas cartridges</p> <p>make a hole</p> use up, make a hole in a well ventilated outside place

 please dispose of these as combustible garbage

Plastic containers and wrapping film

twice a month or to a Recycle Center
in a bag specified for plastic

<p>plastic bags</p> packages of sweets, rice bags, instant noodles, etc	<p>plastic containers</p> ice cream and puddings plastic containers	<p>packs, trays</p> cup noodles, meat, fish etc trays (colored), egg cases
<p>bottles</p> shampoo, soy sauce	<p>wrappings</p> wrapping films from cigarettes, noodles etc	<p>return white trays to the shops that collect them</p>

● please take lids off the containers ● please rinse with water ● unwashable items - to combustible garbage

Recyclable (no specified bags)

Recycle Centers or monthly to a place designated by a local residents association (chōkai or chōnaikai)

<p>fluorescent light tubes, thermometers, sphygmomanometers</p> ● please put in a package of the new item or wrap in a newspaper ● if broken please put in a half-transparent bag	<p>batteries</p> alkaline, manganese, button cells used batteries	<p>empty cans</p> <p>please rinse used cans etc</p> <p>aluminium cans, steel cans, other steel cans</p> seaweed, milk, canned food etc	<p>empty bottles</p> <p>transparent (white), brown, (black, blue, green etc)</p> <p>● please return reusable bottles (beer bottles, isshō sake bottles) to vendor shops</p>
<p>PET bottles</p> <p>take caps off, take labels off</p> ● please do not crush when disposing ● dispose caps and labels as plastics	<p>paper packs</p> <p>● if there is an aluminium foliage inside dispose as combustible garbage</p>
